Important

Obtaining a place in our nursery does not guarantee your child a place in our school for entry at infant or primary school age. There is a different admission criteria that applies for admission to infant and primary school entry. You must apply again in September before your child's 4th birthday for admission to an infant school (even if your child attends the same school nursery that operates mixed classes of nursery and reception and reception children in a foundation stage teaching setting or attends a co-located children's centre). If your child is a pupil at our nursery, we will advise you when the necessary forms for Reception admissions become available.
